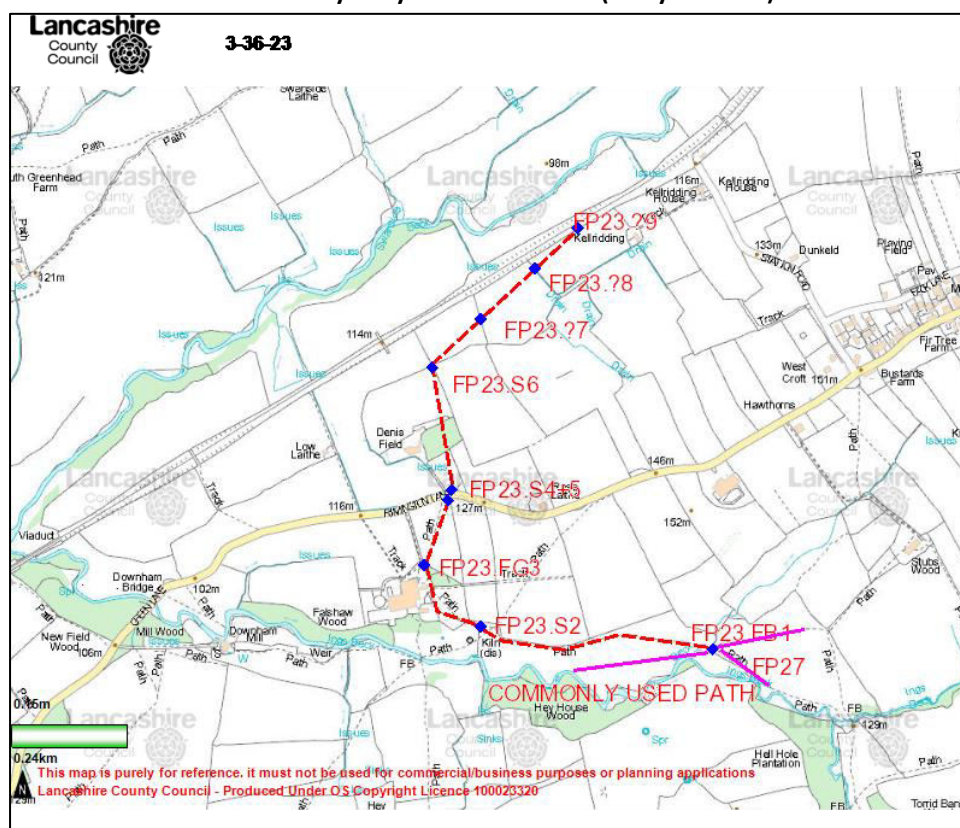

23.S2	Stile Cross Step  SD 7953 4513	<p>Ignore this stile which is on Path 24    Get to this marker – straight on to Stile 23.S2</p>   <p>This is correct stile (23.S2) for Path 23</p> 
23.FG3	Farm Gate  SD 7941 4525	<p>After Stile 23.S2 follow lane to end – turn right at yard (view looking back) – go along right hand side of roadway to double gates</p>  
23.S4	Stile Cross step  SD 7947 4540	<p>Diagonally across field aim for large brick gateposts. !!Busy Road</p>  
23.S5	Stile Cross Step  SD 7948 4540	<p>Cross road from 23.S4 &amp; Stile 23.S5 is few yards up road from Hall entrance Path goes into Hall grounds – cross grassland to gravel path</p>  <p>(SEE FOOT OF PAGE RE DIVERSION)</p>

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23.S6	Stile Cross Step  SD 7943 4567	Along gravel path to next grassland. Follow hedge to stile in corner
