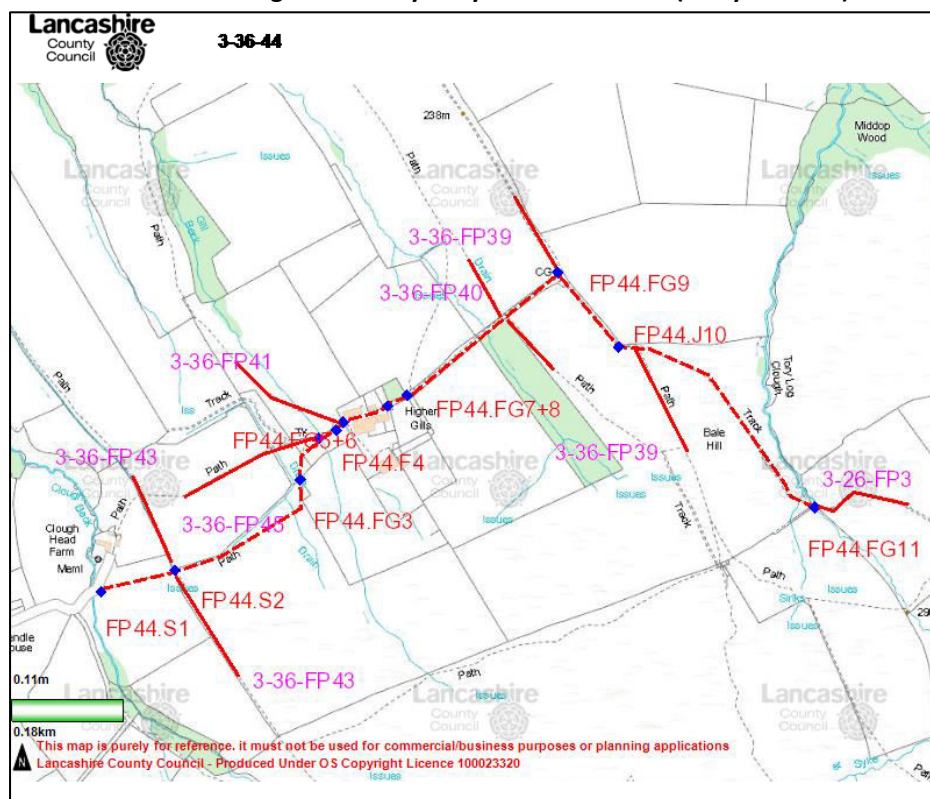

44.S2	Stile Stepover SD 8230 4384	From Stile S1 head straight uphill 
44.FG3	Farm Gate SD 8250 4399	After Stile S2 continue ahead along keeping wall to left until see farm ahead  <i>Insert pic of farm from path after stile</i> Head towards farm until gate seen on left 
44.F4	Ford SD 8253 4405	From gate FG3 (top left on photo) head diagonally towards ford (centre of photo). Depth of ford varies according to weather conditions but not deep. 

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






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44.FG5	Farm Gate SD 8255 4407	After ford follow track to farmyard through gate (photo taken from far side) 
44.FG6	Farm Gate SD 8257 4407	Go through gate FG6 into farmyard. After gate follow yard to gate FG7 
44.FG7	Farm Gate SD 8264 4441	Carry on through farmyard with holiday let flats to left to gate FG7 Photo taken looking back after passing through gate FG7 
44.FG8	Farm Gate SD 8267 4412	Continue along track to gate FG8 at entrance to farm. Photo looking back 

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44.FG9	Farm Gate SD 8292 4429	<p>After leaving farm continue along track until sharp bend after approx. ¼ mile Farm Gate FG9 is on right leading on to moorland. This is where FP44 & FP39 run together until end of wall on left: see 2nd pic & feature J10 below</p>  
44.J10	Junction With 3-36- FP39 SD8301 4419	<p>At end of wall follow track around corner. (FP39 carries straight on). After corner go diagonally uphill (keep to right of hawthorn - track not obvious). When reach top of rise then track is more obvious: see 3rd photo</p>   
44.FG11	Field Gate SD 8330 4395	<p>Follow track to far corner of field – gate FG11 will be seen in clough. The gate does open quite easily!!</p>   <p>The path continues as a Middop Parish path (3-26-FP3) to Craven Laithe</p>
